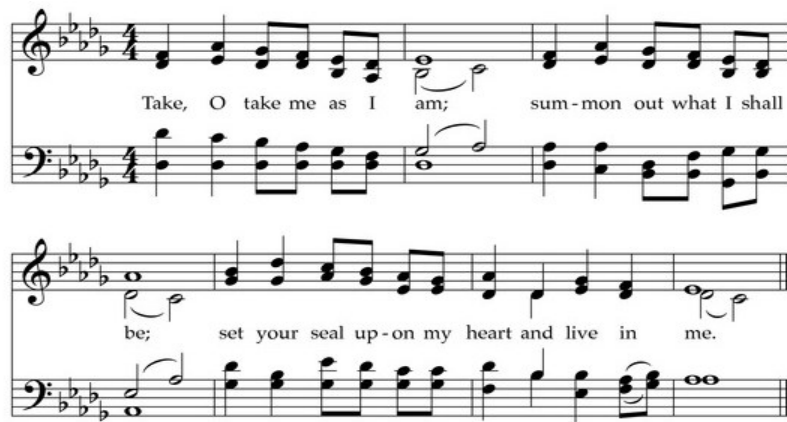


SUMMER PLANS:
